

## BCCS Eligibility

This section describes the criteria women must meet to be eligible to receive low or no cost breast and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic services through a DSHS funded BCCS provider/contractor.



## Eligible Population

**For breast cancer services:** Income at or below 200 percent of the federal poverty level; no other source of payment; women age 50-64 are a priority

**For cervical cancer services:** Income at or below 200 percent of the federal poverty level; no other source of payment; women age 18-64 who have never or rarely (not within the previous five years) been screened for cervical cancer are a priority
